Work party dates are already being planned for the Spring, the dates will be posted in the club newsletter and discussed at the upcoming general meetings.


Enjoy the last few months of Western New York winter and hopefully a trip or two to the tropics.


### **Lake Erie's Fury**

NOAA FORECASTED LAKE ERIE WAVE HEIGHTS FROM RIPLEY TO BUFFALO OF 14 TO 18 FEET BUILDING TO 18 TO 23 FEET, WITH WAVES OCCASIONALLY AROUND 29 FEET. THE INCREDIBLE FORCE OF THE SOUTHWEST WINDS OF 60 - 70 MPH DRAINED THE EASTERN LAKE ERIE BASIN SENDING MILLIONS OF GALLONS OF WATER TOWARD BUFFALO.
